




STAGE 01 AUDIT PROCESS

The Stage 1 audit is the initial step in the ISO certification audit process. Its primary purpose is to evaluate a company's preparedness for the Stage 2 (certification) audit.





PURPOSE OF STAGE 1 AUDIT

- Assess documentation of the management system.
- Review site-specific conditions and understanding of scope.
- Evaluate if the organization is ready to move to Stage 2.

PURPOSE OF STAGE 1 AUDIT

1. Review of Documentation:

- Management system manual
- Policies and procedures
- Scope of certification
- Organizational structure
- Internal audit and management review records
- Compliance with applicable legal and regulatory requirements

2. Understanding of the Organization:

- Evaluate the organization's context, interested parties, and risks.
- Review objectives and performance metrics.

3. Evaluation of Site and Resources:

- Site layout, infrastructure, and working environment.
- Confirm that necessary resources and staff are available.

4. Review of Internal Audits & Management Review:

- Ensure that the company has conducted internal audits and management reviews and taken necessary corrective actions.

5. Planning for Stage 2:

- Confirm scope and readiness for Stage 2.
- Identify potential nonconformities or areas needing improvement.
- Agree on timing and logistics for Stage 2 audit.

6. Stage 1 Audit Report, including

- Findings
- Observations
- Areas of concern
- Recommendations (if any)

OUTCOME

- Go-ahead for Stage 2 (if ready)
- Or recommendation to improve certain areas before proceeding
